## NOTABLE EVENTS

On January 18th, a report of a possible drunk driver led to the arrest of a 38-year-old woman from Rhode Island. The initial report, and what the deputy found, was that a vehicle was travelling on Amy School Road and at a very slow rate of speed. The driver was contacted and displayed many signs of intoxication. The driver did not cooperate with field sobriety tests. She was arrested and lodged at the County Jail. The woman was charged with driving while impaired, possessing open intoxicants in a motor vehicle, and for not having a valid driver's license.

On January 20<sup>th</sup>, another report of a possible drunk driver led to another arrest for operating while impaired. The deputy found the suspect vehicle backing into a driveway and it became stuck in the snow. The driver, 61-year-old Howard City man, appeared to be intoxicated. This driver, also, did not cooperate with field sobriety tests. The man was arrested and lodged in the County Jail. The man was charged with driving while impaired 3<sup>rd</sup> offense and for possessing open intoxicants in a motor vehicle.
