HIGHLIGHTS

On August 14th, a report of a suspicious vehicle was investigated near the intersection of Almy and Amy School Roads. The caller was checking on property owned by his son when the vehicle was located. The vehicle was reported to be "stripped out". The vehicle was found to be reported stolen to the Michigan State Police and belonged to a car dealer near Greenville. The complaint was shared with the Michigan State Police for their further investigation.
