

HIGHLIGHTS

On February 24, a stolen vehicle was reported in the 6000 block of North Whitefish Road. The victim woke in the morning to find his pickup truck missing from within his barn. Later the same day, troopers with the Michigan State Police responded to a property damage accident and located the stolen pickup truck. An extensive search was conducted near the Whitefish Golf Course in Pierson Township. The suspect was not apprehended. The deputy is still making efforts to identify the suspect.

There were two larcenies reported during the month of February. The first was a report of a stolen GPS unit and the suspect was reported to be an ex-employee of the victim. Arrangements were made to return the items and the victim wanted no further action. The second was the theft of a catalytic converter from a motor vehicle. The two thefts do not appear to be related.
