NOTABLE EVENTS

On December 25th, a report of a crashed snowmobile near Cutler and Gordon Roads was investigated. The snowmobile operator, a 39-year-old Newaygo man, was transported to Spectrum Health Butterworth Hospital for treatment. The man was released from the hospital the same night and lodged in the Montcalm County Jail for Operating While Intoxicated on a Snowmobile.

On December 27th, a structure fire occurred in the 8000 block of Lovelace Drive. The home, a trailer with an addition, was fully involved when responders arrived. After the fire was contained, the homeowner, located in the structure, was found deceased. After a thorough investigation was completed, it was determined the cause of the fire was electric heaters being used in the home.
