

The Emergency Food Assistance Program  
 (TEFAP) in Michigan  
 2020 Income Eligibility Guidelines  
 Effective April 1, 2020

Based on 200 Percent of Federal  
 Poverty Income Guidelines

To be eligible for TEFAP your household must be: In need of emergency food **OR** in a household that meets USDA TEFAP income guidelines **OR** recipient of WIC, CSFP, Cash Assistance (FIP), Food Assistance (SNAP), free/reduced school lunch.
