Resignation of Robert Richards from Planning Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals. A new Chairman will need to be selected.

Cemetery rules are not being followed again with an increasing number of items being placed that are not in compliance with the ordinance. This makes it very difficult to maintain the cemetery grounds. An ad will be placed stating items will be removed, a time frame for owners to remove items and the Township Board will make rounds and remove items not in compliance.
