# **NOTABLE EVENTS**

On January 6<sup>th</sup>, deputies responded to a suspicious person who was walking down the middle of the road, holding a knife in each hand, and was yelling at passing cars. This occurred near the intersection of Maple Hill and Almy Roads. The man, a 47-year-old from Howard City, was located still holding the knives. He eventually dropped the knives and was taken into custody. The man had an arrest warrant for failure to appear.

The victim was enticed into sending personal photos which led to an immediate threat to share the photographs on social media sites unless money was paid. The victim did not send money and no photographs were shared. The suspect is believed to be out of the County and has not been identified.
