

HIGHLIGHTS

During the month of December, four larceny complaints were reported. The thefts included a larceny of tools reported on December 1<sup>st</sup>, a larceny of a catalytic convertor reported on December 3<sup>rd</sup>, a larceny of approximately a dozen Christmas trees reported on December 14<sup>th</sup>, and a larceny of a utility trailer reported on December 30<sup>th</sup>. At this time, there are no known suspects nor is it known if any of the thefts are related. The Sheriff's Office detective bureau is continuing with the investigations.

On December 19<sup>th</sup>, a disturbance at a business in the 20000 block of West Howard City/Edmore Road led to the arrest of a 42-year-old man from Georgia. The disturbance between the Georgia man and another patron led to the man retrieving a handgun from his vehicle. The man was charged with and lodged for brandishing a firearm.
