# **HIGHLIGHTS**

On July 23, the Township Deputy was dispatched to a traffic crash in the 8000 block of Amy School Road. A vehicle had crashed into a tree and no one was around. The owner of the vehicle lived in Rockford and when contacted, stated her 18-year-old son was at a party and was to have the vehicle. A short time later the driver's sister arrived at the crashed car stating her brother contacted her advising the car had been stolen. The sister, while looking for the car, claimed she saw the wrecker and assumed it was headed to where the car would be found. The next day, the driver came to the Sheriff's Office to recover property from the vehicle and gave an account of the previous night's events including the vehicle being stolen from him. As the interview progressed, the driver eventually admitted he had been drinking and crashed the vehicle. The prosecutor's office is reviewing the report for charges of filing a false stolen vehicle report.
